NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned Authority will hold a public meeting at the offices of **IDS Engineering Group, Inc., 13430 Northwest Freeway, Suite 700, Houston, Texas 77040**, said address being a meeting place of the Authority.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 1, 2024, at 6:00 P.M.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Comments from the Public;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held April 3, 2024;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented; consider status of collection of surface water charges, pumpage fees and importation fees, and investment of Authority funds; authorize any action necessary in connection with Authority bookkeeping matters;
4. Approval of Unclaimed Property Report as of March 1, 2024, and authorize Bookkeeper to file Report with State Comptroller prior to July 1, 2024;
5. Review and approval of audit for the Authority's fiscal year ended December 31, 2023;
6. Status of preparation and filing of Annual Continuing Disclosure Report due June 30, 2024;
7. Ratification of the engagement of Arbitrage Compliance Specialists, Inc. to prepare a Fifth Year Arbitrage Rebate Report and a Yield Restriction/Yield Reduction Report for the Two Year Study Period ending November 15, 2024, in connection with the Authority's Series 2019 Revenue Bonds;
8. Financial Advisor's Report, including discussion regarding various financial matters, including:
 - A. Status of communications with the City of Houston ("COH") regarding the COH's FY 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023 True Up Reports related to the Authority's share of Operations and Maintenance Costs of the COH's Northeast Water Purification Plant ("NEWPP"); and

- B. Status of communications with the Texas Water Development Board regarding evidence that the Authority is in compliance with covenants in bond resolutions related to the issuance of the Authority's outstanding bonds;

 - G. Report on status of communications with the COH regarding various water supply issues, including: (i) Luce Bayou Interbasin Transfer Project, (ii) NEWPP Expansion Project; (iii) Northeast Transmission Line ("NETL") – Phase I; and (iv) operational issues concerning the NEWPP;
 - H. Second Supplement to Water Supply Contract between the Authority and the COH in connection with the NEWPP Expansion Project, and discussions with COH and other regional water authorities regarding same, including status of COH's issuance of Cash Call No. 13;
 - I. Third and Fourth Supplements to Water Supply Contract between the Authority and the COH regarding the design and construction of the NETL, Phase I, and the Authority's pro-rata share of the estimated costs of said projects;
 - J. Report on communications with the COH in connection with the COH's request to utilize the Authority's 2025 Internal Distribution System to serve four (4) municipal utility districts in the COH's GRP;

Approval and execution of (i) Services Agreement between the Authority and Accurate Utility Supply, LLC for installation of Automated Meter Reading technology within the Authority, and (ii) Beacon AMA Managed Solution Master Agreement between the Authority and Badger Meter, Inc. relative to the implementation of a remote meter reading and monitoring system for the Authority; status of communications with Member Districts regarding Right-of-Entry Agreements related to Automated Meter Reading program;
12. Discussion regarding proposed Emergency Water Supply Agreement between the Authority and Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 200 ("No. 200") in connection with the Authority's purchase of ground water from No. 200 in the event of loss of surface water, and proposed amendment of the Authority's Rate Order in connection therewith; authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
