The meeting will be held on Wednesday, August 6, 2025, at 6:00 P.M.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

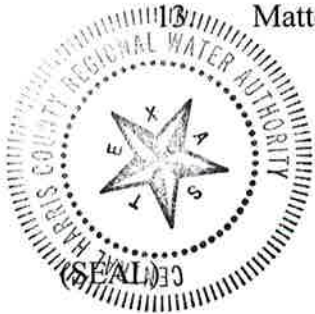
1. Comments from the Public;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held July 2, 2025;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented; consider status of collection of surface water charges, pumpage fees and importation fees, and investment of Authority funds; authorize any action necessary in connection with Authority bookkeeping matters;
4. Review of Annual Operation and Maintenance Accounting for Joint Facilities for Fiscal Year 2024 pursuant to Amended and Restated Joint Facilities Agreement with the North Harris County Regional Water Authority; authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
5. Financial Advisor's Report, including discussion regarding various financial matters, including:
 - A. Status of communications with the City of Houston ("COH") regarding the COH's FY 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 True Up Reports related to the Authority's share of Operations and Maintenance Costs of the COH's Northeast Water Purification Plant ("NEWPP");
 - B. Status of Application to the Texas Water Development Board ("TWDB") for financial assistance from the State Water Implementation Fund for Texas in connection with the Authority's 2025 Internal Distribution System; authorize any actions necessary in connection therewith; and
 - C. Approval of Financing Agreement between the Authority and the TWDB in connection with the Authority's proposed sale of its Series 2025 Revenue Bonds to the TWDB and discussion regarding proposed schedule for same;
 - D. authorize any other action necessary in connection therewith;
6. Engineer's Report, including:
 - A. Report on general engineering matters related to Phase 2 planning activities;

- B. Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of Authority facilities, including:
 - (i) Bid Package 2 of the 2025 Internal Distribution System;
 - C. Review of bids and authorizing the award of construction contracts for construction of Authority facilities; authorizing acceptance of TEC Form 1295, and approval of any related storm water documents;
 - D. Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates and change orders relative to:
 - (ii) Bid Package 1 of the 2025 Internal Distribution System (V&S Construction);
 - E. Report on status of acquisition and acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances required for Authority facilities;
 - F. Report on matters related to the Harris-Galveston Subsidence District ("HGSD"), including: (i) Aggregate Water Well Permit ("Permit") for the period June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026; and (ii) implementation of Amended Groundwater Reduction Plan ("GRP") and proposed amendment of GRP in connection with addition of North Forest Municipal Utility District to same; authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
 - G. Report on status of communications with the COH regarding various water supply issues, including: (i) NEWPP Expansion Project; (ii) Northeast Transmission Line ("NETL") – Phase I; and (iii) request for Additional Reservation of Capacity in Existing Untreated (Raw) Water Facilities;
 - H. Second Supplement to Water Supply Contract between the Authority and the COH in connection with the NEWPP Expansion Project and discussions with the COH regarding future monofil site and funding of same, and discussions with COH and other regional water authorities regarding same;
 - I. Third and Fourth Supplements to Water Supply Contract between the Authority and the COH regarding the design and construction of the NETL, Phase I, and status of receipt of true-up regarding the Authority's pro-rata share of the costs of said projects;
 - J. Status of completion of construction of NETL-Phase II and of preparation of final accounting of costs related to same by the NHCRWA;
 - K. Report on status of the Authority's participation in the NHCRWA's West Hardy Line project (Project 23);
